Changes in a population's size and structure are caused by changes in the birthrate, the death rate, and the net migration rates. Demography, statistical study of human populations, especially with reference to size and density, distribution, and vital statistics (births, marriages, deaths, etc.). Contemporary demographic concerns include the "population explosion," the interplay between population and economic development, the effects of birth control, urban congestion, illegal immigration, and labour force statistics. demography, history of Demography is the study of a human population, a definable group of people, and of additions to and subtractions from its number. A population is increased by births and immigration and decreased by deaths and emigration.
